VACAVILLE POLICE ARREST THREE FOR MARIJUANA SALES

An arrest for marijuana sales resulted in the apprehension of the dealer's suppliers on Friday afternoon.

At approximately 12:43 p.m., Vacaville police officers responded to Arlington Park in South Vacaville to investigate reported narcotics activity. Based on evidence observed, officers obtained probable cause to arrest S-Tyler Flurey, 18, of Fairfield, for possession of marijuana for sale.

During the course of the investigation, the S-Flurey's cell phone continuously rang. An undercover officer answered the phone and began speaking with two individuals who were later identified as being S-Flurey's suspected marijuana suppliers. The undercover officer requested one pound of marijuana be brought to Vacaville in exchange for \$2,500 in cash.

A few hours later, the marijuana suppliers arrived in Vacaville with one pound of marijuana and were arrested for transporting and selling marijuana and possession of a controlled substance.

S-Darius Brady, 22, and S-Amber Shields, 20, both of Ukiah, were then booked into the Solano County Jail.
