VACAVILLE POLICE ARREST RAPE SUSPECT ON A VARIETY OF CHARGES

Vacaville police arrested a man for rape and a variety of other charges after an adult female told police she had been sexually assaulted.

On May 31, 2010, Police received a report from a woman who stated she had been raped by someone she had recently met. She identified her assailant as S-Richard Martinez, 20, of Vacaville.

Detectives from the Family Investigative Response Services Team (FIRST) met with the victim and investigated the allegations and eventually obtained a search warrant for the suspect's residence where the crime had allegedly taken place.

Because of S-Martinez's extensive criminal history, and the victim's statements that a gun had been used during the crime, members of the Vacaville Police Department SWAT team served the search warrant Wednesday morning at an apartment in the 100 block of Aegean Way. S-Martinez was located at the residence and arrested without incident.

A search of the residence resulted in finding evidence related to the sales of methamphetamine, a handgun, and additional evidence related to the sexual assault charges. S-Martinez was transported and booked into the Solano County Jail.
