### **VACAVILLE PD ARRESTS SUSPECT IN PARENTAL ABDUCTION CASE**

On Thursday, Vacaville Police arrested a woman wanted in connection with the abduction of two small children after learning she was at a local shopping center.

S-Kimberly Bruine, 43, was wanted by Carson City, Nevada Police Department for the abduction of the two children, ages 5 and 7, from her ex-husband's home. Investigators from the Carson City Police Department contacted Vacaville Police at approximately 12:13 p.m., after they received information that S-Bruine was at the Nut Tree Village, shopping center located on East Monte Vista Avenue.

Officers contacted S-Bruine in the parking lot along with the two children. S-Bruine was detained and the children were taken into protective custody. Solano County Child Welfare Services is in the process of reuniting the children with their father. During the course of the investigation and detention, S-Bruine became uncooperative with officers and was arrested. She was booked into Solano County Jail.

The Vacaville Police Department FIRST office is working with detectives in Carson City to facilitate a warrant from Nevada for Parental Child Abduction. It is expected that S-Bruine will be arrested for the warrant and transferred to Nevada to address the parental abduction charges.
