Narrative:

On July 16, 2010 at approximately 11:50 PM the Vacaville Communication Center received numerous calls of shots fired near Markham Avenue. Patrol units and Crime Suppression Team (CST) members converged on the area and discovered two victims suffering from gunshot wounds.

The investigation has revealed that a group of four young adults were attending a birthday party in the Markham Heights area of Vacaville. The four adults, two males and two females, went to a liquor store on Markham Avenue. The group drove up to two pedestrians walking on Markham Avenue near Rocky Hill Road. A short argument ensued between the two groups that escalating with one of the pedestrians firing numerous rounds into the victim's vehicle. The weapon was described as a semi-auto handgun.

Two of the occupants were struck by the gunfire, one male sustained serious injuries. This victim was transported by air ambulance to a local trauma center for treatment of his wounds. His condition was been described as series but stable. A female victim received a minor injury to her leg and was treated at a hospital and later released.

The Investigative Service Section (ISS) was called out to investigate this incident, and the investigation is still ongoing. Anyone who has information about this crime is urged to contact Detective Anderson at (707) 449-5200.
