POLICE MAKE SEVERAL ARRESTS IN PROSTITUTION STINGS

As part of an ongoing investigation and effort to curtail prostitution and other crimes in Vacaville, Detectives from the Vacaville Police Department's Investigative Services Section (ISS) conducted a series of stings that resulted in several arrests.

The focuses of these enforcement actions were women who were posting ads on the internet offering to complete sex acts for money in Vacaville. An undercover police officer posing as a customer was used in these cases. The following people were arrested as a result of these efforts:

On July 29, 2010, S-Charlene Agoos was contacted by an undercover officer at a local motel. S-Agoos, 39, of Vacaville was taken into custody for prostitution.

On August 3, 2010 S-Karla Noriega, 18, of Fairfield was contacted and arrested by police for prostitution. S-Anthony Krout, 25, of Vacaville was also taken into custody for aiding in the act of prostitution. In a separate case S-Ashley Bartlett, 23, of Fairfield was also arrested and charged for the act of prostitution.

A short time later another undercover operation was conducted and S-Tiffani Baker, 24, of Sacramento; S-Tashonda Faison, 23, of Highlands; and S-Denise Martin, 26, of Sacramento were all contacted by police and arrested for prostitution. S-Baker was also charged with pimping.

All of the suspects in these four cases were transported to the Solano County Jail. Pictures of the suspects are attached.

The goal of these operations is to curtail this activity in Vacaville as well as maintain safety in our neighborhoods for residents and visitors alike.

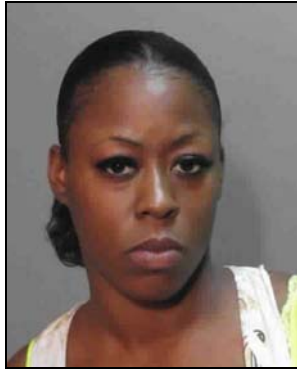
