### **LATE-NIGHT INCIDENT LEADS TO ARREST ON MULTIPLE CHARGES**

Vacaville police arrested a suspect late Thursday night after residents reported a man in the 100 block of Kendall Street with a gun.

On Thursday, August 12, 2010 at approximately 11:30 p.m., officers responded to the scene and were told that S-Anthony Salazar, 26, of Reno, NV was armed with a shotgun and had fired several shots outside the residence. S-Salazar was in Vacaville visiting friends and family.

Officers contacted S-Salazar in the back yard of the residence in the 100 block of Kendall and he was taken into custody. A weapon was also recovered at the scene. There were no reported injuries.

The investigation revealed that during the incident S-Salazar would not allow the people in the residence to leave. S-Salazar was booked into the Solano County Jail for possession of an illegal weapon, discharging a firearm into an inhabited dwelling, false imprisonment, possession of methamphetamine, and possession of a firearm with narcotics.
