### **Narrative:**

On Friday, October 8, at 10:20 PM, Vacaville Officers were dispatched to One Town Center, after receiving 911 calls alleging a man with a gun was in the area. Several victims claimed that a white male adult, who was loitering in the downtown area, had just pointed a handgun at them. Officers also located a victim who had been "pistol-whipped" by the suspect armed with the handgun.

During the investigation, the suspect was positively identified as S-Shenandoah Stevens, a local Vacaville resident. At approximately 11:09 p.m., Stevens was arrested at an apartment complex in the 300 Block of Brown Street and booked into the Solano County Jail. S-Stevens was charged with Brandishing a Firearm, Assault with a Deadly Weapon, and Violation of Probation.
