### **Narrative:**

On November 13, 2010, at approximately 11:48 p.m., the Vacaville Police Department received a phone call from Kaiser Emergency Room staff reporting that a 9 month old child was in the emergency room being treated for serious head injuries.

Officers responded to the hospital and contacted S-Colleen Hernandez, the mother of 9 month old child. The child was being treated for multiple fractures to the head and was unresponsive. The child was eventually transported by helicopter to UCD Medical Center and is currently in critical condition. The mother was then interviewed by police and taken to the police department while an investigation was conducted.

Detectives from the Family Investigative Response Services Team (FIRST) interviewed S-Colleen Hernandez and S-Michael Hernandez and found the couple has a history of reported child abuse and prior arrests which involved their two older children. S-Colleen Hernandez and S-Michael Hernandez were arrested and transported to Solano County Jail for the above referenced charges and "No Bail" has been granted.

Solano County Child Welfare Services responded to the residence and took custody of their other child, a 3 year old who was found at the home with his father at the initial time of call.
