Suspect Information:

The suspect was described as a black male adult in his mid to late twenties. The suspect was average height, had a thin build and was clean shaven. He was last seen wearing a black T-shirt, frameless prescription type glasses with rectangular lenses and a black baseball cap with the inside brim being purple in color. The suspect was armed with what appeared to be a 9mm semi-automatic handgun.

Suspect Vehicle Information:

The suspect vehicle was described as a black mid to late 90's Lexus 4 door sedan with metallic gold logo lettering. The vehicle had stock rims and tires. The vehicles rear windows were tinted extremely dark with the front windows having a lighter shade of tint.

Narrative:

On November 12, 2010 at 6:03 p.m., the Vacaville Police Department's Communications Center received information there was a shooting victim on Cherry Glen Road. Vacaville Police Department officers responded and located a 27 year old male from Concord lying next to his vehicle, suffering from a single gunshot wound to the leg. The injury was not life threatening and the victim was ultimately transported to the UC Davis Medical Center in Sacramento for treatment.

The investigation revealed the victim and two male passengers were traveling on I-80 westbound as they passed through Vacaville. While on the freeway the victim noticed the suspect vehicle tailgating closely behind him. The suspect motioned for the victim to take the Cherry Glen Road off ramp which he did. The victim pulled to the side of the road and the suspect vehicle passed. The suspect made a U-turn and began to drive back toward

the victim who exited his vehicle. The suspect stopped his vehicle a short distance from the victim, produced the handgun and fired a single round at the victim which struck him in the leg. The suspect drove past the victim and fired an additional two more rounds which struck the victim's vehicle.

The suspect was last seen driving eastbound on Cherry Glen Road towards the off ramp. It is believed the suspect may have drove up the off ramp and got back onto I-80 westbound. A search began for the suspect and his vehicle with assistance from the Solano County Sheriff's Department, and the California Highway Patrol. The suspect and his vehicle were not located.
