UPDATE: NAME OF SUPECT IN DOUBLE-HOMICIDE RELEASED POLICE ARREST SUSPECT IN EARLY-MORNING DOUBLE HOMICIDE

Vacaville police have arrested a suspect in the shooting of three people that took place early Tuesday morning.

Police began receiving calls of shots fired in the 500 block of William Street at approximately 1:50 a.m. Upon arriving on the scene police found a woman suffering from gunshot wounds lying in front of the home. Upon entering the home, two more gunshot vicitims were discovered. Both were determined to be dead at the scene. The woman in front of the home was transported to a hospital and is expected to survive.

While police were at the scene reports of a male carrying a handgun in the 600 block of Merchant Street lead officers to the police department at 660 Merchant St. where they encountered an armed male adult in the lobby of the building. Police confronted the suspect on the stairs leading into the police lobby. The suspect, Richard Ruben Calkins, 18, of Vacaville was taken into custody.

This incident is still under investigation and police believe the Calkins may be responsible for the shooting on William Street. The names of the victims will be released by the Coroner of Solano County. More press releases will be issued as information becomes available.
