### **HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION YIELDS ARREST OF SUSPECTED DRUG DEALER**

Vacaville police have arrested a 16-year-old juvenile suspected of selling drugs as part of the on-going investigation into a double homicide that took place November 16, 2010. Police believe he supplied the drugs that were present in the apartment at the time of the shooting.

Detectives with the Vacaville Police Department's Investigative Services Section (ISS), aided by the Vacaville Police Department's Crime Suppression Team (CST), conducted a probation search at a residence in the 1200 block of Balsam Way in Vacaville.

During the search of the 16-year-old probationer, items believed to be psilocybin mushrooms, marijuana and pills were found. The drugs, cash, packaging materials and other evidence found were consistent with sales. The juvenile was arrested and booked into the Juvenile Hall.
