NEW INFORMATION REGARDING SEXUAL ASSAULT & STABBING

The Vacaville Police Department learned this afternoon in Solano County Superior Court that S-Alexander Cervantes, the suspect in Sunday morning's attempted homicide and sexual assault, will continue to be held in the Solano County Juvenile Hall on \$9 million bail. S-Cervantes will be tried as an adult by the Solano County District Attorney's Office for the following listed charges:

- 2 counts - Attempted Murder
- 2 counts - Burglary
- 1 count - Sodomy on a Child under 14 Years of Age
- 2 counts - Oral Copulation on a child under 14 Years of Age
- 2 counts - Aggravated Mayhem
- 2 counts - Torture
- 1 count - Assault with intent to Commit Rape
- 1 count - Sexual Penetration with a Foreign Object
- 1 count - Rape on a Child under 14 Years of Age
- 1 count - Forcible Lewd Act upon a Child

There is no new information regarding the condition of the victims, who were listed in critical condition, but are expected to survive. This is an ongoing investigation, and as more information becomes available in this case, press releases will be issued.
