Narrative:

On December 19, 2010 at 1:14 a.m., the Vacaville Police Department received 911 calls in reference to shots being fired at the Buena Vista Apartment complex located in the 1400 block of Alamo Drive. One of the callers reported their apartment had been struck by gunfire. There were no reported injuries.

When officers arrived they discovered an apartment in the complex had been struck by gunfire at least twice. One of the bullets penetrated the exterior of the apartment and made its way inside, coming to rest in the victim's flat screen television. Several witnesses were contacted in the area. The witnesses reported seeing the suspect jump the east fence into the complex. This fence backs up to a small field adjacent to the trailer park at 1495 Alamo Drive. The suspect then fired at least three rounds towards the victim's apartment from what appeared to be a small caliber handgun. The witnesses described the suspect as a Hispanic male, 16-19 years old. He was 5'4" – 5'8" and was wearing black jeans and a black hooded sweatshirt pulled up over his head. The suspect was last seen jumping back over the fence towards the trailer park.
