POLICE STING AND SEARCH WARRANT RESULTS IN FOUR ARRESTS

As part of an ongoing investigation and effort to curtail prostitution in Vacaville, detectives from the Vacaville Police Department's Investigative Services Division (ISS) continued an investigation into prostitution in Vacaville that resulted in several arrests.

At 3:45 p.m. on January 7, 2010, S-Cam Truong, 48, was arrested at Fuji Massage for prostitution as well as being unlicensed for massage or escort and posing as a massage therapist while exposing oneself. S-Truong was booked into Solano County Jail.

The investigation continued on January 12, 2010, when detectives conducted a sting operation against a suspected prostitute at an apartment at the 1500 Block of Alamo Drive.

S-Christina Lamb, 36, was arrested for prostitution, pimping and keeping a house for the purposes of prostitution. Also arrested was S-Michelle Fisher on charges of prostitution. Both women were booked into Solano County Jail.

As part of the investigation, an anticipatory search warrant was served at S-Christina Lamb's residence on the 2100 Block of Newcastle Drive where S-Samuel Lamb, 41, who is Christina's husband, was contacted. During execution of the warrant, a usable amount of MDMA, commonly called Ecstasy, was located. Samuel Lamb was arrested and booked into Solano County Jail for possession of a controlled substance.

This is the second criminal case brought against Christina Lamb and Samuel Lamb concerning the act of prostitution. The pair was arrested in November 2009 on similar charges.

The goal of these operations is to curtail this activity in Vacaville as well as maintain safety in our neighborhoods for our residents and visitors alike.

Under state and local law, property owners are required to ensure that criminal activity does not occur on their property. As a result, a Community Safety Ordinance violation letter is being sent to the owner of the residence and the business, Fuji Massage.

The purpose of the letters is to inform the owners of violations that have occurred on their property that are considered a public nuisance, and the need of the property owners to take appropriate and reasonable action to prevent or address those violations.
