Narrative:

On January 08, 2011 at 9:30 p.m., Vacaville Police responded to the area of the 100 block of E. Hemlock Street to search for a 3-year-old girl who was missing from her residence. The child's mother was interviewed and said that she had left the child in the home alone and gone to a local grocery store and then to a friend's house. Upon returning home, the 3-year-old was missing. An officer located the young child, barefoot and in her pajamas, standing in the 100 block of West Street. The temperature at the time of this call was approximately 38 degrees and a light drizzle was falling. The mother had also been consuming alcohol. The 3-year-old, along with her 4-year-old sister and 5-year-old brother, were taken into protective custody and turned over to Child Welfare Services. The mother was arrested for child endangerment and booked into the Solano County Jail.
