### **VACAVILLE POLICE ARREST TWO IN RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY**

Vacaville police arrested a pair of suspects following a home burglary that took place Tuesday morning.

Officers responded to a residence in the 100 block of Woodhaven Drive following a report of a possible burglary in progress after a resident saw the suspects carrying suspicious items. The resident also reported seeing one of the suspects jump the fence into the backyard of the residence.

The two suspects left the area in a 1990s gold Honda station wagon. A short time later, a Youth Services Officer spotted the vehicle near the scene and began following it. During the pursuit, one of the occupants threw a 9mm handgun out of the window on Longview Drive. The handgun, which was later recovered, was identified as a stolen handgun from the residence on Woodhaven Drive.

The suspects' car was pulled over, and S-Andrade Shortly, 20, and S-Maurice Hanks, 20, both of Vacaville, were arrested without incident. During the high-risk traffic stop, Sierra Vista Elementary School was put on lockdown for approximately 10 minutes, due to the proximity of the traffic stop to the school.

During their investigation, officers found that the residence on Woodhaven Drive had been broken into. Additional stolen guns and jewelry were found outside the residence and recovered.

S-Shortly and S-Hanks were charged with burglary, possession of a stolen firearm, possession of a stolen firearm in a vehicle, conspiracy, and theft of firearms.
