Narrative:

On February 17, 2011 at approximately 3:32 p.m., Vacaville Police Officers were summoned to 171 Butcher Road, regarding a battery investigation. Officers met the victim of the battery and determined that she and the suspect, Jon Peel, have a dating relationship and live together in the city of Winters. The victim indicated that the two were involved in an argument which quickly escalated into a physical fight. At one point, s-Jon Peel struck the victim. A witness to the incident attempted to stop S-Peel from continuing to beat the victim. S-Peel removed a small knife from his pocket and threatened the witness. When S-Peel learned that the police had been called, he left the business at 171 Butcher Road.

Vacaville units quickly established a perimeter and surrounded the area, utilizing K-9 Cir to conduct a search for S-Peel, who was located hiding in the bushes near an adjacent business. S-Peel refused to surrender or follow commands given by officers and was apprehended by the police canine. S-Peel sustained minor injuries during the arrest process and was booked into the Solano County Jail.
