Narrative:

On the above listed date and time Vacaville Police Department Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Allison Drive in reference to a suspicious device found inside one of the telephone utility boxes. An AT&T employee reported he had opened the utility box for routine maintenance and found a suspicious device inside the box, wired into the telephone lines. Multiple other AT&T employees were contacted and the origin of the device could not be determined. As a precautionary measure the Travis Air Force Base EOD unit and the Yolo County Bomb Squad were called out. Traffic on Allison Drive was disrupted for a period of time as a safety measure. After an extensive examination of the device it was determined to be a non-explosive electronic device. AT&T and the Vacaville Police Department are continuing the investigation to determine the origin of the device as well as any criminal intent.
