STANDOFF ENDS WITH ARREST OF VACAVILLE STABBING SUSPECT

Police have arrested a Vacaville resident wanted in connection with a stabbing that took place a little over a week ago outside a local liquor store.

Following a 2½ hour standoff, Vacaville police arrested S-Rocky Salgado Lujan, 27, of Vacaville for allegedly stabbing another Vacaville man, intimidation of a witness and possession of methamphetamine. S-Lujan is a suspect in a fight and stabbing that took place outside the Depot Food & Liquor store in the 800 block of Markham Avenue.

On Friday July 15, 2011 at 2:02 a.m., the Vacaville Police Department Communications Center received a call from employees at Vaca Valley Hospital. They reported a 27-year-old Vacaville man had come to the emergency room suffering from stab wounds.

An investigation revealed a fight took place outside the Depot Food & Liquor in the 800 block of Markham Avenue between the victim and S-Lujan. After the fight, the victim got into the passenger seat of a vehicle. S-Lujan reached into the passenger side of the vehicle and stabbed the victim multiple times on the chest and hand. During their investigation of the incident, officers developed probable cause to arrest S-Lujan for assault with a deadly weapon, but S-Lujan was not located at the time and it was believed he fled the Vacaville area.

A number of witnesses to the fight and stabbing have told police they have been threatened by S-Lujan in an effort to dissuade them from testifying.

On Saturday, July 23, 2011 at 10:56 p.m. officers responded to S-Lujan's residence in the 600 block of Arcadia Drive. As they approached, they observed S-Lujan through the open blinds inside the living room. S-Lujan quickly closed the blinds and shut off all lights. Several telephone and verbal requests were made to S-Lujan in an effort to get him to peacefully surrender but went unanswered. After an approximate two and a half hour standoff, S-Lujan finally made phone contact with officers and agreed to peacefully surrender. He was taken into custody without incident. Also located inside were his 27-year-old girlfriend and their two-year-old son.

A search warrant was obtained for the residence to search for evidence related to the stabbing. Potential evidence related to the stabbing was found as well as almost one ounce of crystal methamphetamine. S-Lujan was arrested and booked into Solano County Jail for assault with a deadly weapon, witness intimidation and possession of methamphetamine.

The victim has since been released from the hospital and is recovering from his stab wounds.
