3 SACRAMENTO AREA RESIDENTS ARRESTED ON MULTIPLE CHARGES

On Thursday evening, Vacaville Police arrested three suspects for child endangerment and allegedly taking property without paying from several stores at the Vacaville Premium Outlets.

A concerned citizen requested a welfare check on two young children who were in a car with an adult who was smoking marijuana. The citizen reported a strong odor of marijuana coming from the car. The caller reported that the male exited the car with the children and walked towards 378 Nut Tree Road. The caller provided a description of the car and the occupants. Officers responded to the area saw the car attempting to leave the parking lot at a speed too fast for conditions.

Officers made an enforcement stop at 310 Orange Drive. Officers approached the car and noted the strong smell of marijuana emanating from the car. Investigation revealed the driver, S-Danwione Bishop, 34, was on probation out of Sacramento County for Domestic Violence and DUI. His driver's license was also suspended. S-Roman McKnight, 36, a passenger in the vehicle, was on probation for armed robbery.

Officers located marijuana and stolen property from the Vacaville Premium Outlet stores. Officers observed a 5-month-old, and a 3- and 6-year-old not properly restrained in the car. Officers removed the children from the car and noted the strong smell of marijuana coming from them.

S-Walker, S-McKnight and S-Jacklyn Vitola, 20, all of Sacramento, were arrested and booked into the Solano County Jail on a variety of charges, including child endangerment, parole violation, and possession of stolen property. The children were taken in to protective custody and released to Solano County Child Welfare Services.
