On July 29, 2011, Detectives from the Family Investigative Response Services Team (FIRST) received notification of possible unlawful sexual intercourse involving a part-time employee for the City of Vacaville and a 14-year-old male. The suspect, Katrina Herrador, 21, a program leader since May 2011 for the City of Vacaville summer camp program called Teen Extreme, had become acquainted with the 14-year-old male who attended the camp sessions.

During the early morning hours of July 29, 2011, the parents of the victim discovered suspicious text messages, which prompted their reporting of an unlawful sexual relationship between their son and Herrador. It is alleged that during the late evening of July 28, 2011, Herrador participated in unlawful sexual intercourse with the victim at her Fairfield residence.

Herrador was removed from duty by the City of Vacaville on July 29, 2011 and resigned from employment on August 1, 2011. On August 2, 2011, Detectives met with S-Herrador and arrested her for the above allegations. At this point in the investigation, it does not appear that any misconduct or criminal activity occurred during the summer camp program sessions. The Vacaville Police Department has an ongoing investigation and is asking the community for assistance. If you witnessed any inappropriate behavior involving S-Herrador toward any summer camp program participants or have any additional information to provide regarding this investigation, please contact Detective David Marsh at (707)469-6616.

A media conference has been scheduled for 6 p.m. on August 3, 2011 at the Vacaville Police Department Emergency Operations Center, 660 Merchant St. in Vacaville. Police and City officials will discuss the case at that time. Please do not call in advance of this media conference.
