FOUR ARRESTED IN CONNECTION WITH PAIR OF BANK ROBBERIES

The Vacaville Police Department has arrested four suspects wanted in connection with two bank robberies that occurred in late July in Vacaville and that they believe may be responsible for as many as 10 bank robberies in Northern California.

Detectives obtained arrests warrants for S-Jordan Michael Moore, 19, and S-Danielle Jolene Casab, 20, both Vacaville residents, and the two were taken into custody today at approximately 6:30 a.m. in front of their apartment at 6800 block of Leisure Town Road.

S-Sylvester Moore, 37, of Vacaville was also arrested at the scene for a parole violation. S-Sylvester Moore apparently lived with S-Jordan Moore and S-Casab in an apartment the trio moved into last week. S-Michael Conniff, 21, of Vacaville was also taken into custody at the apartment. It is believed that S-Conniff participated in a bank robbery in another jurisdiction.

Identification of the suspects in the Vacaville bank robberies, which was made last week, was made possible by forensic evidence that was collected and processed from the robbery scenes. Police believe that evidence will connect all of the suspects to the Vacaville robberies, and may be useful to other police agencies interested in the suspects. Once identified, detectives obtained arrests warrants for the suspects but were unable to locate them. The arrests were made after the San Francisco Police Department (SFPD) received a tip about the suspect's location and passed it on to Vacaville detectives.

Several local and federal law enforcement agencies have been working cooperatively on this series of robberies in an attempt to locate the fugitives. The Vacaville Police Department would like to thank SFPD for their assistance in finding these fugitives.

Narrative:

On July 25, 2011 at approximately 11:20 a.m., the City of Vacaville Communication Center began receiving several calls of a bank robbery at the Wells Fargo bank located at 3061 Alamo Drive. Patrol units responded to the call and set up a perimeter for the suspect. A search was conducted using a police K-9 and a CHP fixed wing air unit. The search did not uncover a suspect.

Detectives from the Investigative Services Section (ISS) responded to the bank and took over the investigation of the robbery. Initial reports indicate that the suspect scaled the counter armed with a black semi-automatic handgun. He ordered the bank employees to open their money drawers. The suspect collected an undisclosed amount of cash from these drawers and was seen fleeing the bank on foot. He was last seen crossing Nut Tree Road a short time later running to the rear of the Auto Zone Store. The suspect was described as wearing a black mask over his face. Please see the attached photo for further details on the suspect's description.

The initial investigation indicates that this case is related to the Chase Bank robbery that occurred on July 19, 2011. Both crimes occurred in the same shopping center. It is possible the same person may be responsible for both crimes. Wells Fargo Bank has offered a reward of up to \$10,000.00 for information leading to the capture of the responsible.
