Car Stop Nets Three Arrests

Narrative:

On September 9, 2011 at 8:11 p.m., Vacaville Police Department Crime Suppression Team (CST) Detective Keith Hopper made a car stop in the 500 block of Alamo Drive. When the vehicle pulled over, two (2) male occupants exited and immediately ran from the car. The female driver later identified as 20 year old Vallejo resident S-Brandy Bouman remained in the car. She was detained and found to have an outstanding warrant for her arrest. A small amount of methamphetamine was found on her person. A search of the vehicle incident to her arrest revealed a loaded shotgun inside which was accessible to all three (3) occupants. S-Bouman is a convicted felon and prohibited from possessing firearms.

A perimeter was set up for the two (2) males that fled. One of the males, identified as 42 year old Vallejo resident S-Robert White was located within minutes a short distance away on Grandview Court. He was taken into custody after a brief foot chase for resisting arrest. A small amount of methamphetamine was also found on his person. S-White was also identified as a convicted felon, prohibited from possessing firearms.

Officers at the scene requested assistance from the California Highway Patrol's Air Unit. A helicopter responded and searched the area. The outstanding subject was not located and after approximately one hour officers left the area.

An undercover detective from Vacaville Police Department's Narcotic Enforcement Team (NET) remained in the area in an unmarked vehicle. At 10:46 PM, a subject matching the description of the male who fled from the vehicle earlier was seen walking southbound on Alamo Drive near Grandview Court. A silver Dodge Intrepid was in the area as well being driven by a female. The vehicle was driving back and forth on Alamo and it appeared the driver was looking for someone.



The Narcotic Detective saw the female driver pick up the male in question and they headed southbound on Alamo toward Merchant Street. This information was given to uniformed officers and a car stop was made. A male passenger was detained and identified as 46 year old Vallejo resident S-Christopher Miller. S-Miller was positively identified as the subject who fled from the vehicle earlier. S-Miller was found to be wanted on an outstanding parole violation warrant. He also had two outstanding drug violation warrants out of Solano County.

The female driver of this vehicle was briefly detained and released after it was determined she had no knowledge S-Miller was wanted.

S-Bouman was charged with possession of methamphetamine and an outstanding Solano County warrant. S-White was charged with resisting arrest and possession of methamphetamine. S-Miller was charged with violation of parole and the two (2) Solano County drug related warrants. All three (3) subjects were charged with being felons in possession of a firearm and booked into Solano County Jail.
