POLICE ALERT RESIDENTS TO PAIR OF RESIDENTIAL BURGLARIES

The Vacaville Police Department is alerting residents to a pair of recent residential burglaries that may be related to similar incidents in another Solano County city.

On September 12, 2011, police received reports of two (2) separate burglaries in the Browns Valley area. In both cases, the suspect entered residences during evening hours while residents were at home. Police believe the two (2) cases are related and may also be connected to a similar crime trend in Suisun City.

Detectives from the Investigative Services Section (ISS) are working several leads on these cases and networking with the Suisun City Police Department. Police are asking residents to be vigilant in securing their property at night and to report any suspicious activity immediately. Officers are conducting increased patrols in the affected areas.

The Vacaville Police Department wants to remind everyone that we live in a safe community and that police will do everything possible to identify and arrest the suspect in this case.
