VACAVILLE POLICE INVESTIGATE SUSPICIOUS CIRCUMSTANCE NEAR CALLISON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Narrative:

The Vacaville Police Department is investigating a suspicious circumstance near Callison School that occurred on Friday afternoon. A parent reported that her five year old son was crossing the street from Callison School on his way home.

The child reported that a white male adult with a white beard similar to that of Santa Claus was seated in a charcoal colored pick-up truck. The child described the truck as being similar to that of a Ford F150 truck. The male was wearing a red baseball cap and said, "Hey buddy come here – I wanna talk to you about something." The child did not respond to the male.

The child was standing by himself at the time; however, there were other children nearby as school had just ended for the day. The child arrived home and told his mother. The mother went to look for the truck, but it was no longer there. Officers conducted an extensive area check, however the truck was not located.

The Vacaville Police Department would like to remind parents to talk with their children about stranger danger. In this case the child did everything right, he did not answer the male, he did not cross near the truck and he went straight to his home that was nearby and told his mother immediately.
