POLICE SEEK SUSPECTS IN EARLY EVENING HOME INVASION ROBBERY

Vacaville police are looking for four men involved in a home invasion robbery that took place Monday evening just after 8 p.m.

The Vacaville Communications Center received a call of a home invasion robbery that had occurred in the 1000 block of Opal Way, at which time patrol units responded to the scene and contacted two adult victims and five juvenile victims. The children ranged in ages from 1 to 14 years of age. Detectives from the Investigative Services Section (ISS) and crime scene technicians responded to assist with the investigation.

Initial reports indicate that the grandfather answered a knock on the door and was met by four masked gunman. The suspects forced their way into the home and held all the victims in the living room at gunpoint. The suspects demanded money and ransacked the house, spending almost two hours in the home and continually threatening the victims with guns. The suspects spoke in both English and Vietnamese.

No one was injured during the incident and the victims are being offered counseling through the Vacaville Police's Family Investigative Response Services Team (FIRST) Office.

An undisclosed amount of cash, a shotgun and other personal property was taken from the residence. The investigation is ongoing and anyone with information is asked to contact the Vacaville Police at (707) 449-5200 or Detective Mark Ferreira at (707) 449-5258.
