WOMAN, TWO JUVENILES ARRESTED FOR CONSPIRACY, BURGLARY

Vacaville police arrested a woman and two juveniles after they attempted to break into a home while the resident was still inside.

The Vacaville Communications Center received a call on Wednesday evening from a distressed female who stated someone was attempting to break into her home in the 800 block of Marshall Road. The female stated the subjects were trying to kick open the back door to her home. Officers arrived at the 800 block of Marshall Road and detained three individuals in front of the victim's home.

S-Laura Walsh, 27, of Vacaville was identified as the driver of a silver Jetta parked in front of the victim's home. Police learned that S-Walsh picked up the two 17-year-old males in Fairfield and drove them to Vacaville so they could burglarize homes in the Vacaville area. The three suspects were targeting homes with no vehicles in the driveway. The two male juveniles were unsuccessful at kicking open the rear door to the victim's home, but had removed two screens from windows to this residence.

The two juvenile suspects were arrested for burglary and booked into Solano County Juvenile Hall. S-Walsh was arrested for conspiracy and booked into Solano County Jail. This investigation is ongoing. Anyone with information is asked to contact Officer Carly Broaddus at 707-449-5200.
