### **Narrative:**

On June 4, 2011 at 3:10 AM, the Vacaville Police Department Communications Center received two 911 calls. The callers reported 15 – 20 subjects fighting in the street in the 1100 block of Bedford Way. The subjects were possibly associated with a house party in the area. When officers arrived on scene, several of the subjects fled on foot in multiple directions. A loaded 45 caliber revolver was located in the street near the area where the subjects fled. Officers were unable to determine who the owner of the firearm was.

While on scene, the communications center received a 911 call from a 19 year old male from Vacaville. The male indicated he had been stabbed. Officers located the victim a short distance away from Bedford Way at the intersection of Nut Tree Road at Northampton Court. The victim told officers he was involved in the fight in the 1100 block of Bedford and fled the area on foot. While running he noticed he had been stabbed and called 911. The victim sustained two stab wounds, one to his abdomen and the other to his upper back. He was transported to the UC Davis Medical Center in Sacramento by ground ambulance. His injuries were not life threatening. The victim could provide no details as to who stabbed him.
