## **SIX SACRAMENTO RESIDENTS ARRESTED ON MULTIPLE CHARGES**

### **Narrative:**

On Thursday evening, Vacaville Police arrested six suspects for thefts from multiple Vacaville stores, as well as possession of counterfeit checks, probation violation, and an outstanding arrest warrant.

At approximately 6:52 p.m., an employee at one of the Vacaville Premium Outlets called the police department to report a group of individuals had just been inside of the business and had stolen merchandise inside. The caller also reported that they believed one of the suspects had paid for a purchase with a counterfeit traveler's check. The employee indicated the suspects were now possibly in another business.

Officers responded to the area and contacted the suspects as they exited another of the Vacaville Premium Outlet store. Subsequent investigation revealed the suspects were in possession of property stolen from the store they were exiting as well as additional counterfeit traveler's checks. S-Nakemia Brazelton was found to be in possession of a "Booster Bag" used to steal merchandise from retail businesses.

In total, stolen property from five Vacaville businesses was located in the suspects' possession as well as their vehicle. Investigation revealed all of the suspects had acted in concert in the thefts. All six suspects were booked into the Solano County Jail for a variety of theft and fraud related charges.
