HIGH-SPEED PURSUIT NETS TWO BURGLARY SUSPECTS; ONE MORE SOUGHT

A high-speed pursuit that started just after noon in Vacaville ended in Fairfield with the arrest of two home burglary suspects.

On Thursday, at approximately 12:04 p.m., Vacaville police received a call of a residential burglary having just occurred on Green Tree Drive. A witness saw two suspects carrying the victim's property out of his house and driving off in a silver-colored Cadillac.

An officer spotted the vehicle travelling on westbound I-80 near the Alamo Street exit and began following the vehicle, joined a short time later by other Vacaville units. The vehicle drove onto Cherry Glenn Road where officers initiated a traffic stop. The vehicle refused to yield and headed back to Vacaville on eastbound I-80. The vehicle exited on Alamo Street and headed south, but turned around and got back on the freeway, heading westbound on I-80. During the pursuit, the Cadillac reached speeds of 90 mph, driving along the freeway shoulder. The vehicle eventually took the Waterman Boulevard exit in Fairfield, ran off the road and crashed into some bushes near Hilborn Drive. The three occupants then fled on foot from officers.

Units from the Fairfield Police Department and the California Highway Patrol assisted in searching for the suspects. A perimeter was set up around the area and Edward Anderson, 29, of Vallejo was found hiding in a backyard on Lighthouse Drive in Fairfield and was taken into custody.

A second subject, William Foote, 28, of Oakland was located in a nearby Round Table pizza restaurant and was also taken into custody. Officers recovered stolen property dropped by both suspects and stolen property was also found in the car.

Vacaville officers went to the Green Tree Drive address and found the front door of the home had been kicked in and the interior of the house had been gone through. The two suspects were positively identified by witnesses to the burglary and were booked into the Solano County Jail. The third suspect is still outstanding.
