Fee effective 3/1/2006, pays ongoing fixed costs associated with sewer collection, treatment, and discharge.

Sewer variable units are based on your average residential water units used during low-use winter months. It is recomputed annually in spring.  
(Average residential sewer use is 17 units bimonthly.)

Service charge determined by meter size connection (5/8", 3/4", or 1" for typical residence). The meter size connection defines the amount of water available to you on demand, and is billed regardless of the amount of water used. It helps to cover the fixed costs of having quality water available, 24 hrs per day.

The City has a two-tiered billing system during normal water years.  
Tier 1 billing 1-12 units  
Tier 2 billing > 12 units  
12 units X .75 = 9.00  
22 units X 1.03 = 22.66  
34 units = \$31.66

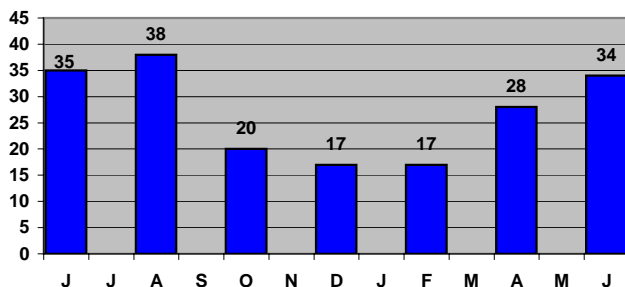
Vacaville passed Measure I in 1988 to pay for municipal improvements and uses utilities billing system to collect tax.

**Amount Due: 121.95**

**Remaining Customer Credit Balance:**

Amount due upon receipt. A late fee of \$10 or 10%, whichever is greater, will be charged if full amount is not paid before delinquent date. This bill reflects a sewer rate increase approved by council in 2003. This increase helps fund the California mandated environmental improvement renovation and expansion of the Easterly Wastewater Treatment Plant.
